

How to Care for Your Art

Congratulations on your artwork purchase. Your art will provide a lifetime of enjoyment with just a little care. Here are a few tips to protect your investment.

Where to hang your print?

Avoid placing the art in direct sunlight. Ultraviolet light and the heating effect from sunlight can cause fading and damage (even when the art is protected by a UV blocking glazing). In addition, avoid areas with high humidity such as a bathroom and areas with wide temperature variations such as a hot attic, above a working fireplace, or in front of a heating vent.

How to clean your print?

The front of your print is TruLife Acrylic which is an anti-reflective, abrasion resistant, anti-static, and UV blocking acrylic developed specifically for face mounting photographs. It captures details with lifelike colors, incredible depth, and clarity for the highest-resolution viewing experience possible.

Your print will need very little care, but you can clean your print as follows:

- Spot-clean viewing side with a dry lint-free or microfiber cloth by wiping in a soft, circular motion.
- When needed, use a non-ammonia glass cleaner or make cleaning solution by mixing 1 part water and 1 part isopropyl alcohol. Apply cleaner onto cloth and then wipe.
- Do NOT use an acrylic cleaner or polishing agent. Do NOT try to hand polish or buff scratches in this product as it may cause damage to the coating.
